



Deadlines: The Statewide Judicial Emergency [orders](#) of the Supreme Court of Georgia toll deadlines for filings in the Court of Appeals, absent a specific order to the contrary from this court. See the Supreme Court website for more details. Parties are strongly encouraged to continue filing briefs and motions within the pre-Emergency Motion time frame.

Operations: The Court of Appeals remains fully operational. There will be sufficient personnel on site to take paper filings from pro se parties. Although all deadlines are tolled, parties are encouraged to meet the normal deadlines when they can. The Court will continue to rule on applications by the statutory deadlines.

Oral arguments: Oral arguments will be held by video conference only for the remainder of 2020.

Admissions: All attorney admissions will be conducted remotely, at the on-site admission fee rate. For directions on remote admissions, click [here](#). Typically attorneys requesting remote admissions via e-mail are admitted within twenty minutes of receipt of their e-mail. No attorney admissions will be conducted at the Court until further notice.
